



## Pattie Chipman Anderson

January 27, 1924 - June 6, 2016

Pattie Chipman Anderson (age 92) passed away peacefully in her home after a long illness on June 06, 2016. She and her twin sister, Pauline “Polly” Chipman Sauls, were born on January 27, 1924 in Greenville, GA. She moved to Atlanta, GA around the age of 5 and spent the majority of her life there. 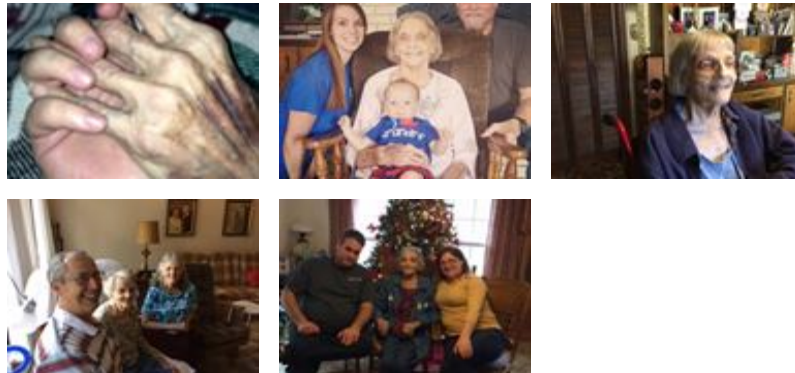

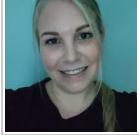
