



Dr. Perry Moore

July 16, 1930 - July 26, 2018

Funeral services for Dr. Perry Moore, age 88, will be conducted Monday, July 30, at 2 pm in St. Stephen's Episcopal Church with Father David Probst officiating. The family will receive friends at Williams Funeral Home in Milledgeville on Sunday from 2 PM until 4 PM.

Dr. Moore passed away on July 26, 2018. He was predeceased by his wife Stella; his parents, John Henry Moore and Willie Mae Parker Moore; siblings, John Henry Moore, Jr., William H. Moore and Thomas L. Moore.

A native of Montgomery, Alabama, Dr. Moore was a veteran of the U.S. Navy where he became an X-ray technician. He went to college at Mercer University. He entered the Medical College of Georgia after his Junior year at Mercer. He earned his medical degree and BSM (in Medicine) from Mercer at the same time in 1960. During his college education, Dr. Moore supported his family as an X-ray technician. He practiced medicine and later

completed a Residency in Radiology.

Dr. Moore made Milledgeville his home in 1966 and established his private practice in Baldwin County Hospital as a board certified Radiologist. He was a member of St. Stephen's Episcopal Church.

Survivors include his daughter, Darlene (Jim) Coleman of Atlanta; sons, Douglas (Linda) Moore of Milledgeville, Kenneth Moore of Austell, and David Moore (Bert Scott) of Orlando, FL; sister, Martha Ann Jackson of Prattville, AL; brother, Lt. Col. USAF (ret.) Robert L. Moore of Columbia, S.C.; and grandchildren, John Moore of Milledgeville, Douglas Moore, Jr. (Mary) of Milledgeville, Dorrier Coleman (Kelsey) of Atlanta, Kevin Moore of Atlanta, Alex Moore of Marietta, and Andrew Moore of Austell.
