



## Poin Galloway, Sr.

March 26, 1931 - December 12, 2024

Poin Dexter Galloway, Sr., age 93, of Milledgeville, passed away Thursday, December 12, 2024. Funeral services for Poin Galloway will be conducted on Sunday, December 15, 2024 at 3:00pm in the Chapel of Williams Funeral Home of Milledgeville with Rev. Tim Thomas officiating. Interment will follow in Baldwin Memorial Gardens. The family will receive friends at the Williams Funeral Home of Milledgeville on Sunday, December 15, 2024 from 2:00pm until the service hour.

A native of Elizabethtown, KY, Poin was born on March 26, 1931 to the late Earnest Galloway and the late Florence Woodfill Galloway. In addition to his parents, Poin was preceded in death by a daughter, Jill Galloway, and by 9 brothers and sisters. Poin moved to Milledgeville in the 1960's and operated Rocket Roller Rink until 2015. He loved exotic animals and entertaining children. Poin was a veteran, having served in the Korean War as a "Frogman" in the Navy SEALs.

Poin is survived by his wife, Devona Hall Galloway of Milledgeville ; his son, Dexter (& Jodi) Galloway of Milledgeville ; and his grandchildren, Hunter, Evan, Karli, Addison, Savannah, Sydney, and Sienna.

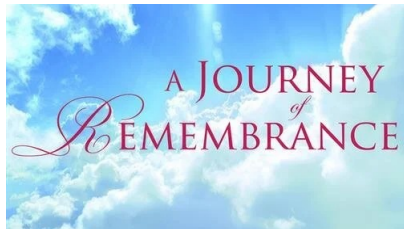

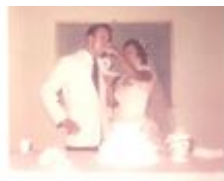

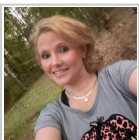
