Mr. Ralph Wise Warren, age 61, passed away Friday, November 19, 2010. Funeral Services will be held Friday, November 25, 2010 at 2PM in Discipleship Christian Center with Dr. Gregory Hunt and Eulogist Bishop Gus Cooper officiating. Interment will be private.

Mr. Warren was a native of Washington County but had lived most of his life in Hancock County. He was the son of the late William Henry Warren and Elizabeth Wise Warren. Mr. Warren was a graduate with the Hancock Central class of 1967, attended Tuskegee State and Ft. Valley State Colleges and earned a Bachelors Degree from Morris Brown and a Masters Degree from Ohio State university. He began his career in education with Hancock County Board of Education and retired as principal of M.E. Lewis Elementary School. He was a Kappa Alpha Psi member and a member of Hunts Chapel AME.

He is survived by his wife Donna Elaine Hunt Warren of Sparta; daughter Joycelyn Warren; son Joshua Warren both of Gray; step children Sanjanetta (Daryl) Lewis, Jay (Tammy) Milline, Jr., Lakeycia McGhee, Shakia Dawkins, and Anthony Quinn Dawkins, Jr.; five grandchildren and brother Tracy Champion.
