Randall Maurice "Randy" Cannon, age 67 of Milledgeville passed away Friday, January 14, 2022. A private memorial service will be held at a later date.

Randy was born July 29, 1954, in Vidalia, Georgia, to the late Hazel Sharpe Cannon and the late Maurice Earl Cannon. Randy grew up in Warner Robins, Georgia and was a member of the Warner Robins High School Class of 1972. He earned his Bachelor of Arts degree from Georgia College & State University. He began his career at Milledgeville-Baldwin County Allied Arts in 1979 and retired as Executive Director of Allied Arts in 2015. Randy was passionate about the arts and he wholeheartedly supported the mission of Allied Arts to make available a broad range of experiences in the performing arts, visual arts, literacy arts, heritage arts and general arts education for all the citizens of Milledgeville and Baldwin County.
