Lewis Randall “Randy” Jones, age 69, of Milledgeville, passed away Monday, July 6, 2020. 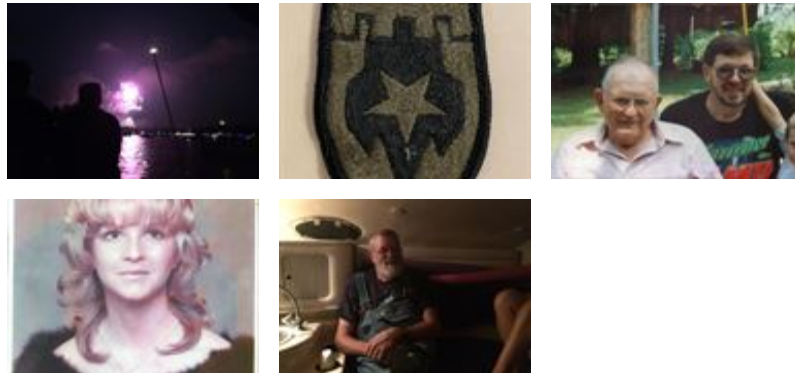
