



## Rev. Lee Daniel (Eatonton)

July 6, 1918 - February 10, 2011

Rev. Lee Eldon Daniel, age 92, passed away Thursday, February 10, 2011. Funeral Services will be held at Williams Funeral Home Chapel in Milledgeville on Sunday, February 13, 2011 at 5PM with Rev. Jerry Bradley officiating.

The Family will receive friends on Sunday at Williams Funeral Home in Milledgeville from 4 o'clock until the service hour.

Rev. Daniel was a graduate of Bible Baptist Institute and was ordained on October 25, 1942 at Eloise Baptist Church in Winter Haven, Florida.
