Mr. William Richard Dennard, age 76 passed away on Saturday January 2, 2021 at his residence under the care of Regency Southerncare Hospice after a long battle with Pulmonary fibrosis. A native of Gordon and Milledgeville, he had recently moved to Statesboro. Richard graduated from Georgia Southern University in 1966 with a BS in Marketing. He returned to Wilkinson County where he began a long career in the kaolin industry with Engelhard/BASF corporation. He became their Packaging and Transportation Manager. Because of his knowledge and customer service skills, he traveled extensively for Engelhard as their liaison, trouble shooter, and problem solver. He retired in 2009. He was preceded in death by his father W.C. Dennard, Jr. and mother Richie Stapleton Dennard Lavender and a brother Charles Dennard. Richard had a love for building projects and landscaping, so he was often the chairman of the church building and grounds committee at First Baptist Church, Milledgeville, GA.
