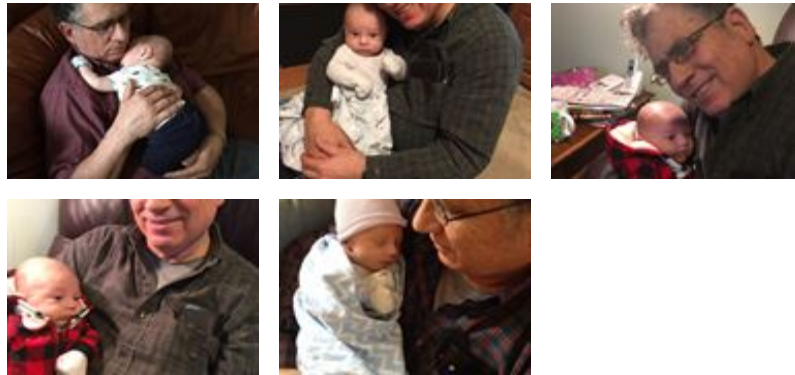
Leslie, Leah and family, may God comfort you and give you newfound strength knowing Rick's final destination. I'm sure my Aunt Leen is smiling!

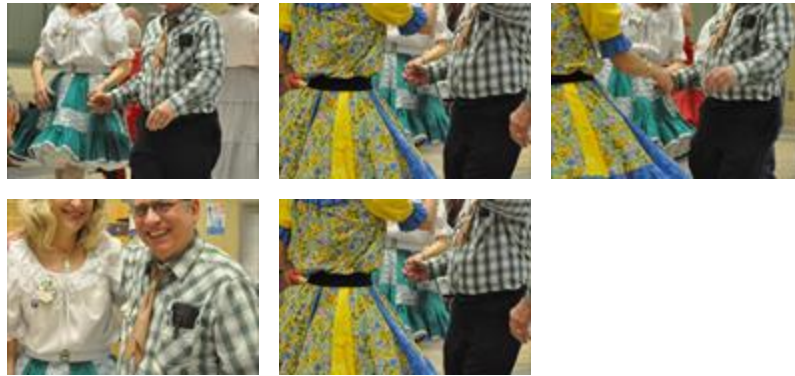

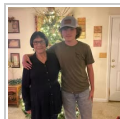
