Robert Melton Goocher, age 73, of Warthen, passed away Saturday, September 14, 2024. A Celebration of Life for Robert Goocher will be conducted Saturday, September 21, 2024 at 11:00 am in the Darien Baptist Church with Rev. David Ray officiating. There will be a visitation, with covered-dish dinner, following the service at the Old Linton School.

A native of Eatonton, GA, Robert was born on April 8, 1951 to the late Harrell Melton Goocher and the late Katherine Wilson Wall. Robert was a veteran, having served in the U.S. Air Force. Receiving his Associate's Degree in Criminal Justice, he spent a lifetime in law enforcement, beginning his career with the Putnam County Sheriff's Department and the Milledgeville Police Department, and finishing his career with the Washington County Sheriff's Department.
