During high school, Roland, Harold Davis, and I attended a Midway High School basketball game in nearby Gray. Well, upon returning home, we were stopped by a state trooper (Sergeant Combs), who presented me, the driver, the ticket. He had been sitting at the intersection, observing the steady traffic following the exodus of cars from the game. The trooper accused me of not stopping at the crossroads and implied that we took the corner on two wheels. He was right! I did! And I thought that Roland and Harold would have cardiac arrest once we were confronted. And I was the one who got stuck with the ticket! To say that I was embarrassed is an understatement. That was no way for a regular church goer to act. Consequently, I enrolled in a Driver Education course at the school (taught by Coach Moore) in order to improve my driving techniques.

I learned a valuable lesson then. And it did not happen in a classroom. That wild night in a '50 Chevie prompted me to make an attitudinal adjustment that has stayed with me all my life.
