Mr. Ronald L. Dykes, age 77, passed away Thursday, November 29, 2012. Funeral Services will be conducted Monday, December 3, 2012 at 11AM in the First Baptist Church of Milledgeville with Rev. 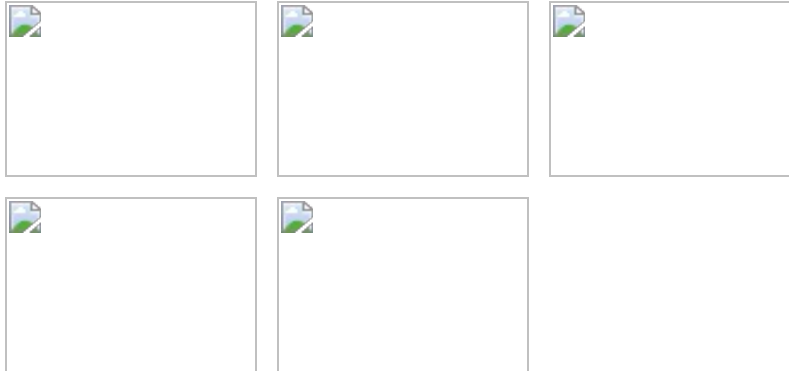
