Rosa Marie “Rose” Freeman Hartley, age 80, of Milledgeville, passed away on Thursday, February 27, 2025. 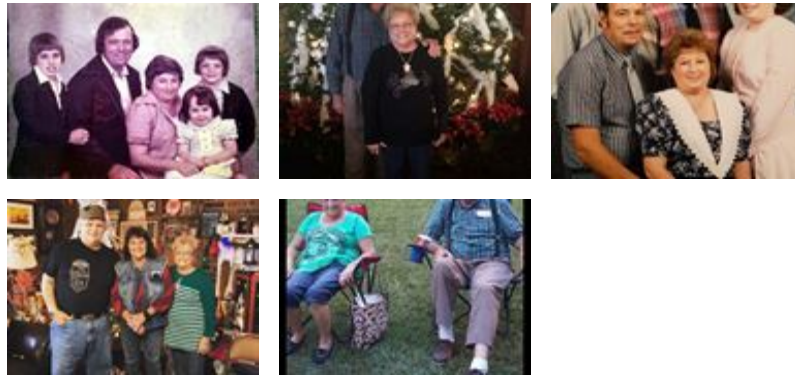
