Ryan went home to be with the Lord after a very courageous six week battle with a malignant brain stem tumor.

Ryan graduated from Brookwood High School and received a BS in psychology from Georgia College and State University, Milledgeville, Ga in 2005. He loved his job and coworkers in the human resources department of the Georgia Dept of Transportation. He was an active member of ChristChurch Presbyterian, serving on the men's ministry team and teaching Sunday school. He was honored to be nominated as a church deacon before his illness.

Ryan loved being outdoors, ran the Peachtree several times and thoroughly enjoyed hiking to the bottom of the Grand Canyon with his father and sister. He loved to travel and served on a variety of mission trips. Ryan had a gentle spirit, deep faith, and a very giving heart, always ready to help a friend in need or lend a helping hand.

He is survived by his parents, Dale and Shela Baird, his twin brother Derrick, sister Melissa and her husband Coy Bailey.

Ryan's Memorial Service will be held on Saturday, June 27th at ChristChurch Presbyterian, 1740 Peachtree St, Atlanta 30309. Visitation is from 1:00-3:00, with the service to begin at 3:00. The internment service will be held on Sunday at 1:00 at Baldwin Memorial Gardens, Milledgeville, Ga.
