Sara Green Farrar, age 95, died July 24, 2009. A resident of Green Acres Nursing Home in Milledgeville, Mrs. Farrar was born in Smyrna, Georgia on May 13, 1914 to Grover Cleveland and Lena May Gann Green. She graduated from Marietta High School in 1932 and worked with her father in his optometry practice at the Peachtree Arcade in Atlanta until she married Virgil Payne Farrar of Waynesboro, Georgia, on September 19, 1937. Upon settling in Marietta, Mrs. Farrar became active in the Elks Club, the Civitan Club, the Marietta Garden Club and the Y.W.C.A. She was a dedicated volunteer at Kennestone Hospital and a member of the First Methodist Church in Marietta, where she taught Sunday school for many years. She was a member of the Smyrna Social Club, Daughters of the American Revolution, United Daughters of the Confederacy, and Washington Family Descendants. She worked with her late husband at Reynolds & Farrar Drug Co., and owned the Knit and Gift Shop. She also worked at Lois Ashworth's Style Shop and Nob Hill Apartments. She was predeceased in death by her parents, her husband Virgil, her brother, Grover Cleveland Green, Jr., and three sisters, Virginia Williford Green, Mary Russell Carter, and Laura Alice Hamrick. Mrs. Farrar is survived by her daughter, Sally Farrar Daniel, and her husband Jack Daniel of Milledgeville; her son, Virgil Payne Farrar, III of Blairsville; three grandchildren: Sally Brown of Milledgeville, Farrar Davis of Macon, and Frazure Farrar of Atlanta; four great-grandchildren: Ivey and Emma Brown of Milledgeville, and Morgan and Payton Davis of Macon; and several nieces and nephews.
