At Georgia College, Sharon majored in dance. She worked for GTE Telephone Company for more than 22 years. After the deregulation of the phone company, Sharon worked for Arby's, Shrimp Boat, ERA Realty, K-Mart and Creekside Elementary School.

After retirement from the Baldwin County Board of Education, Sharon became a stay-at-home grandma.

Sharon is fondly remembered for her work as a Girl Scout leader and the leadership she shared with Peter for the Boy Scouts.

Sharon Piro is survived by her sister, Suzanne Jackie Shead and many friends in Milledgeville and Middle Georgia where she had lived since 1961.
