March 30, 1946 - December 11, 2024

Stan Mauldin, age 78, of Milledgeville, passed away on December 11, 2024. Stan was born in Anderson, SC to the late Arthur Maurice Mauldin and Elise Wells Mauldin. He graduated from Georgia Southern and moved to Milledgeville in 1973. Stan then taught Driver's Education, Health, and Physical

Education, and coached wrestling, football, and baseball at Baldwin High school

and GMC until he retired in 2003. He was an active member of Milledgeville First

Methodist Church, where he sang in the choir, was a member of Methodist Men,

and served on the board of Noah's Ark Preschool. He also supported the Meals

On Wheels program in the community by serving on its Board and delivering meals for many years. Stan proudly served his country in the US Navy from 1967- 1971. He had a strong faith in God, loved his family and friends, and was a

devoted and beloved son, brother, husband, father, and grandfather (PawPaw).

He is survived by his wife of 57 years, Janet Mauldin, of Milledgeville; his daughters Shannon Mewborn (Randy) of Hartwell and Shelley Tiefenbach (Nate)

of Swannanoa, NC; his sisters Judi Saylor (Olin) of Atlanta and Maurica Parks

(Rick) of Lula; and grandchildren Hannah Bentley, Hayden Bentley, Camden Bentley, and Madi Bentley, Ava Tiefenbach, and Jaxson Tiefenbach.

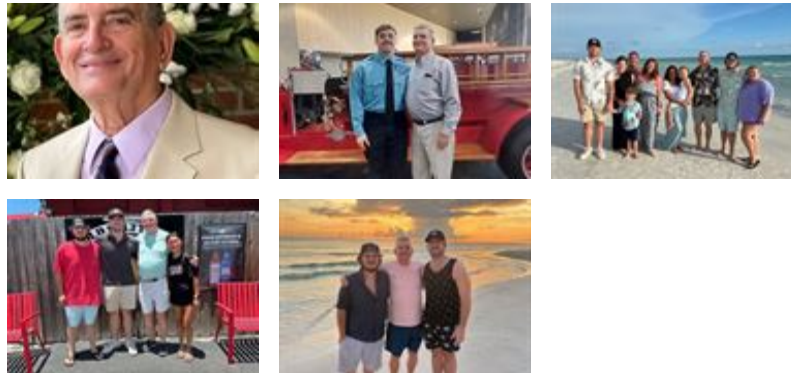
