



## Sue Ellen Lane

August 23, 1943 - October 7, 2025

Mrs. Sue Ellen Lane, 82, passed away on October 7, 2025. A funeral service will be held on October 11, 2025 at 2 PM at the Williams Funeral Home Chapel in Milledgeville Ga. Burial will be at Heritage Memorial Park. The family will receive friends at the funeral home on Saturday following the service and clubhouse at the Harbors in Milledgeville. Sue Ellen was born 8-23-1943 in Anniston Alabama. Her parents were Ila Sue Ervin Sapp and Emerson E. Ervin and step father Richard (Dick) Sapp. She grew up in Anniston, Ala with her beloved grandmother, grandfather, aunts, uncles and cousins and then was transferred to Germany for several years with her stepfather, mother and sisters and ended up in Augusta, Ga as her stepfather was enlisted in the army. Upon Graduation from Richmond Academy in Augusta Ga. she attended Augusta College where she met the love of her life Larry Lane. They married and moved to Eatonton Ga. in 1967 and started the radio station WXPQ. In 1970 they moved to Macon, Ga. where Sue Ellen was a homemaker and later served as membership director of River North Country Club. She and Larry spent lots of time at their lake house at Lake Sinclair, Ga. as Sue Ellen loved the lake. In 1994, they moved from Macon to Lake Sinclair as their primary residence. Sue Ellen was an accomplished tennis player, bridge player, and known for her love of the late great ELVIS. She was fondly known for greeting staff at her assisted living homes with titles of Elvis song titles such as "If you're looking for trouble, you've come to the right place! She was quite the character in later life and will be greatly missed. Mrs. Lane was

preceded in death by her husband, Larry Lane.

She is survived by her daughter, Lauren Lane Hailey of Atlanta/Lake Sinclair, son Lawrence "Kerry" Lane (Stacie) of Madison, sisters Karen Mobley (David) of Augusta, Jean Watson (Randy) of Augusta; grandchildren, Chenault "Nault" Hailey, Holland Lane Hailey (Brooke), Hunter Lane, and Karlie Lane.
