Mr. Thadieus Philip "T.P." Taylor, age 71, passed away on February 25, 2017. Funeral Services will be held on Wednesday, March 1, 2017 at 11:30 AM in the Williams Funeral Home Chapel in Milledgeville with Pastor Randy Young officiating. 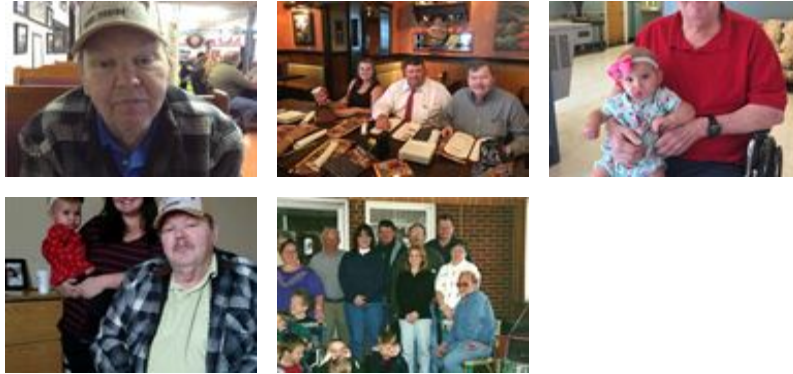
