“ I knew Tap when we were in VS30 in Jacksonville, FL. I depended on several sailors to keep our shipmates' records current, and Tap was the best! Initially, I would check each man's typing to make sure it was letter perfect before it left our office. I soon learned that if Tap said he had checked his work, and it was perfect - it was. I still remember the day I was going through my in box and came across a two or three page document that Tap had typed. Instead of reading it, I turned and called over, "Tap, is this perfect?" When he said yes, I just initialed it and put it in the out box. He was the only one I could count on like that. Keep in mind, this was back in the days of manual typewriters, no spell check.
