Mr. Thomas Allen Bearden Sr., 74, of Lawrenceville, Ga, formerly of Griffin, Ga, passed away Friday, December 28, 2007 at the Georgia War Veteran Home in Milledgeville, GA after a 10 year battle with lung cancer and a 5 month battle with brain cancer.

Mr. Bearden was born in Birmingham, Al to the late Alvin and Ella Bearden.

He retired as a Chief Petty Officer from the Navy after 23 years of service. He was a Naval Electronics instructor and a Veteran of the Korean War. He was the owner of Bearden Electronics in Griffin in the 1970's.
