Thomas Parker "Tom" Moore, age 77, of Milledgeville, passed away Thursday, May 28, 2026. 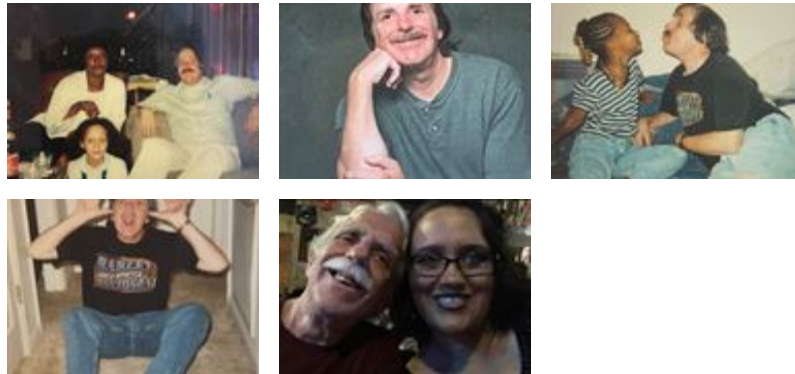
