Mr. Vincent Troche, Jr., age 91, passed away on Sunday, June 25, 2017. Funeral services will be conducted at 1:30PM on Tuesday, June 27, 2017 in the Chapel of Williams Funeral Home of Milledgeville. Interment will follow at Georgia Veterans Memorial Cemetery.

The family will receive friends at the funeral home from 12:30 until the service hour.
