Virginia Moore Towson, of Eatonton, died Thursday afternoon at her home. She is survived by two sons, Lin (Jo) Towson of Milledgeville and Bruce (Debbie) Towson of McDonough and preceded in death by her husband, Earl Towson, and daughter Janice Rickman of Macon. Mrs. Towson also leaves grandsons, Sam Rickman (Lynette) of Conyers, Brad Towson (Keely) of Atlanta, John David Rickman (Lindsay) of Milledgeville, Michael Towson (Jill) of McDonough, and Mc Daniel, Walker Daniel and Chad Kellett, all of McDonough.
