Willard Bryan Moore, Age 86, passed away, Wednesday, August 27, 2014. Funeral Services will be conducted 11 am, Saturday, August 30, 2014 in the First United Methodist Church, Historic Sanctuary, with Rev. Dave Hinson Officiating. Private interment will be held, Tuesday, September 2, 2014 at the Georgia Veterans Memorial Cemetery. The family will receive friends at the church from 10 until the service hour.

Mr. Moore was a native of Carroll County, Georgia, the son of the late Ralph Nelson Moore and the late Florence Huggins Moore and the widower of the late Ann Lee Moore. He was a Veteran of the Korean Conflict serving in the United States Army. Mr. Moore began his career with the Georgia Power Company in Bibb County, worked in Albany and retired from Plant Harlee Branch as Supervisor.
