William "Billy" Arnold, age 78, of Milledgeville, passed away Wednesday, November 20, 2024. 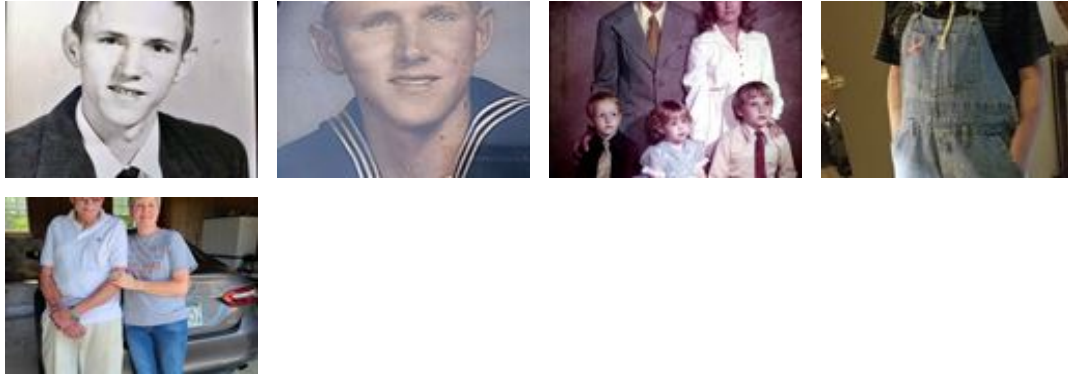
