



## William Calhoun Montgomery, LTC ret

February 5, 1926 - November 24, 2009

Funeral Services for Ret. LTC William Calhoun Montgomery, age 83, who passed away Tuesday, Nov. 24, 2009, will be conducted Monday (11/30/2009) at 11:30AM in the First United Methodist Church of Milledgeville with Dr. Jay Hodges officiating. Burial will follow in the Georgia Veterans Memorial Cemetery with Full Military Honors.

The family will be at the First United Methodist Church from 10:30 until the service hour to receive friends.

Col. Montgomery was a native of Talbot County, GA serving 30 years in the United States Air Force living in Numerous States and Countries and had lived the past 15 years in Putnam County. He was the son of the late Seaborn C. and Bessie Boswell Montgomery and widow of Gladys Hart Montgomery. He was a Veteran of the 32nd Infantry Division during World War II and was awarded a Bronze Star, and later served as a meteorologist with the USAF during the Korean and Vietnam Conflicts and other Crises. After military retirement, he worked as an environmental engineer with Georgia EPD and as a consultant with Courtney Consultants, INC. He was a member of the Executive Board, Atlanta Area Council, Boy Scouts of America, he received the Silver Beaver Award and actively served as an adult volunteer Scouter for over 50 years.

Survivors include daughter Tracy (Mark) Beldon of Marietta; sons Ret. LTC Robert Montgomery of Marietta, Ron (Lynn) Montgomery of Tampa, FL, and Rick (Lisa) Montgomery of Brunswick; his children's mother Edna Scott Montgomery of College Park, GA; and 8 grandchildren.
