Funeral services for Mr. William "Bill" Hartness Duffell age 86 will be conducted Friday, August 30, 2024 at 11 AM in the Friendship Baptist Church at Lake Sinclair (635 Twin Bridges Rd. Mr. Duffell was a native of Bibb County and grew up on a rural farm in Perry, GA though his career in the medical industry resulted in him moving about the United States multiple times. He was a graduate of Perry High School and later attended University of Georgia and later in his adult life obtained a law degree from La Salle Extension University. Mr. Duffell retired at age 74 from Gambro BCT where he provided strategic executive level Regulatory Affairs support to the business.

Mr. Duffell served in the United States Air Force but did far more than just serve his country. He was an accomplished and skilled scuba diver, private pilot, snow and water skier, traveled globally and an avid reader. He was ordained as a Deacon in the Southern Baptist Church in 1978.

He was predeceased by his parents, Jack Waldo Duffell and Marjorie Hartness Duffell and was the eldest of five children four of which have predeceased him; sisters, Jackie Davis and Elizabeth Duffell and a brother Jack Duffell, Jr.

Survivors include his wife of 66 years Karol Denard Duffell; daughter, Kathryn (Chuck) Butler of Lake Sinclair; sons, William "Bill" Duffell, Jr. (Cindy) of Franklin, NC and Roger Denard Duffell (Lana) of Winston, GA; a brother, David Duffell of Byron, GA; 7 grandchildren also survive.
