Mr. William Bryan Larman, Jr. age 87, passed away Wednesday, June 5, 2013. Funeral Services will be conducted Saturday, June 8, 2013 at 4PM in Central Methodist Church with Rev. Carol Davis officiating. Interment will follow in Eatonton Memorial Park.

The family will be at Williams Funeral Home of Eatonton Friday Evening from 7-9PM to receive friends.

Mr. Larman was a native of Green County, born on August 27, 1925 to the late William Bryan Larman and Nellie Williams Larman. He was preceded in death by his brothers Howard, Pate, and Sammy Larman.
