Mr. William Paul "Bill" Thiry age 77 of Milledgeville, Georgia, passed away Saturday, Feb. 25, 2012. Mr. Thiry was a native of Chicago, IL and had made his home in Newark and Arcadia California since 1966, before moving to Milledgeville in 2007.

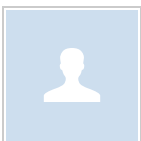
