Willie Lee Sanders, age 87, of Milledgeville, passed away Tuesday, December 16, 2025. Funeral services for Willie Sanders will be conducted Saturday, December 20, 2025 at 2:00 pm in the Chapel of Williams Funeral Home of Milledgeville with Rev. Jim Davis and Rev. Larry Glover officiating. Interment will take place in the Georgia Veterans Memorial Cemetery. The family will receive friends at the Williams Funeral Home of Milledgeville on Saturday, December 20, 2025 from 1:00 pm until the service hour.

A native of Deepstep, Willie was born on January 4, 1938 to the late Tommy Sanders and the late Martha Pounds Sanders. In addition to his parents, he was also preceded in death by his wife, Betty Jean Collins Sanders. Willie grew up in Milledgeville. He served in the U.S. Army at the Signal School in Germany. 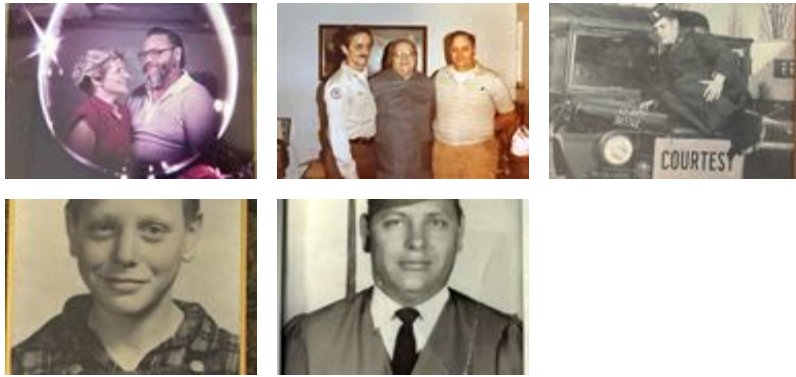
