Mrs. Yoshiko Mitchell, age 74, passed away on Sunday, July 19, 2015. Funeral services will be conducted on Thursday, July 23, 2015 at 10 AM at Sinclair Baptist Church. Entombment will follow at Heritage Memorial Park.

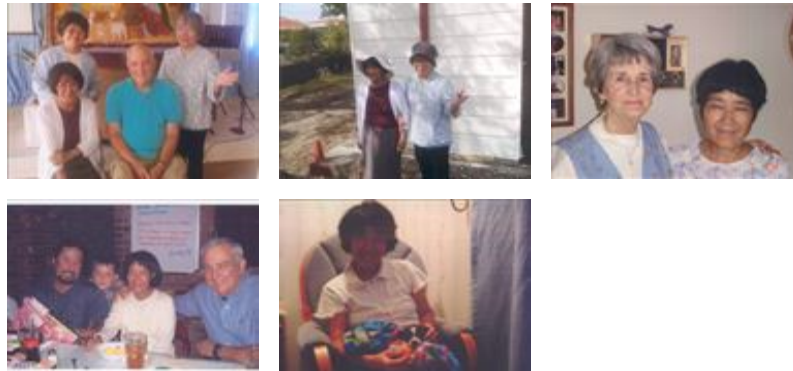
